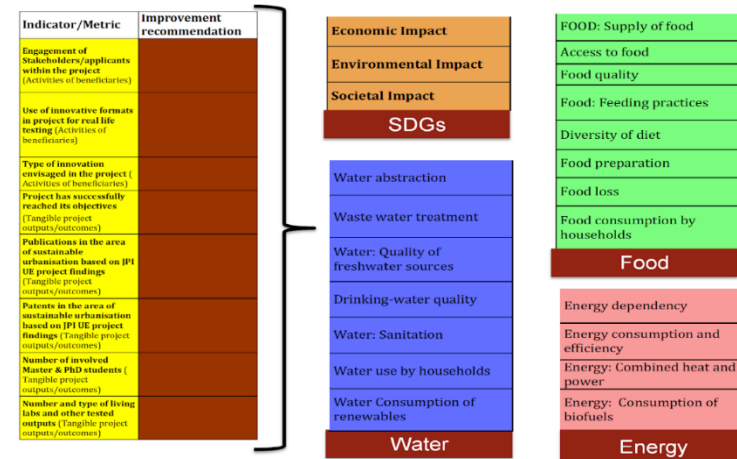


ECIID Activities

The **ECIID** is to support the SUGI Projects by the the SUGI Program Consortium of Funders by running/ongoing/following progress assessment

The ECIID in 2020:

- Ongoing development of an indicators and assessment of innovation and impact delivery **toolkit** to evaluate information provided in Annual Reports submitted by the SUGI Projects
- Proposed enhancements of the **Bfgo Reporting System** and the **JPI Urban Europe Annual Reporting System** to encourage SUGI Projects to consider how innovative strategies and accrued knowledge/tools/models and consortia might be scaled in order to attain broader aggregated impact in terms of benefits to society in terms of sustainable food-water-energy systems in urban context.
- **Interacting** with SUGI Projects and SUGI Program Implementation Group
- Submitted **annual reports of ECIID assessment** to the SUGI Program Consortium of Funders



ECIID findings from Year 2 Reports

- The ECIID focused on **identifying innovative strategies** used by SUGI projects and considering **potential for scaling such innovations**
- Assessing **active engagement of all stakeholders** and **communication** and **outreach activities**
- Key findings:
 - some delays due to Covid-19, most projects are on track
 - overall well reported activity around stakeholder engagement approaches (although differences in co-creation degrees)
 - projects often hesitant in expressing the potential impacts

ECIID suggestions

- For the last reporting phase, ECIID will adjust the template in the toolkit on what to report: not every impact indicator but rather ask for a characterisation of SDG impact
- Projects could mention the most important potential impacts of their work, explain how these impacts are connected to each other and what has to be done in the future to really achieve them
- E.g. the five most important dimensions?
