Conceptualizing Agroecology as a metabolic practice

Agroecology as urban public policy: systematic interrogation of urban development from an agroecological perspective

Critical systematisation of lessons learned within growing communities engaging with agroecology in an urban setting

Living soil and soil care as a new narrative for urban spatial planning

Structuring the interdependence between development at farm level and farmers operating infrastructure at the landscape level

Slide 2: Impacts

What do you expect to be the 2-3 most important short term and long term impacts from your SUGI project?

Building institutional capacity around urban agroecology in Brussels, Rosario, London and Riga

- -initiation of a centre for urban agroecology, Brussels
- -strategic discussion on the future of Lucsavsala island, Riga
- -strategic discussions around fringe farming, London
- -validation of practices carried out by municipal agroecology team, Rosario

Incubation of a sustained dialogue between the agroecology movement and the urban food planning community.

- -Identification of key matters of concern
- -Identification of key policy measures
- -Identification of communities of practice

Significant failures

- -failed attempt to establish a 'quantum farm' in London's Green Belt: identification of legal and planning barriers
- -the polarisation between ecological goals and socio-economic goals within municipal programmes under COVID

Slide 3: Approaches - How will you go about to realize these impacts? What is your approach?

- -we fully shifted online
- -feeding back into the communities we have worked with within the local platforms
- -critical systematisation of lessons learned within 8 building blocks for an agroecological urbanism
- -the construction of **an online resource** around these building blocks
- -the hosting of **four webinars aimed at different communities** we wish to impact consumers-producer solidarity / social movements (care / community kitchen) seeing (with) the farmers (focus on public farmland land) food planning community (local & city to city) urban policy community / local governance community (international)
