In 2020, with the first of a series of calls on the topic of Positive Energy Districts and Neighbourhoods (PED/PEN), JPI Urban Europe invited transdisciplinary and cross-sectoral communities of researchers and practitioners to create smaller-scale joint R&I projects on PED/PEN implementation. The aim of the call was to bring about transnational alignment, comparison and exchange of experiences between ongoing (European) projects in different PED implementation phases, their integration in general urban strategies, stakeholder involvement strategies and the role of geographical/climatic conditions. Four projects were selected for funding.

The kick-off meeting of the PED Pilot Call will bring together the partners from the funded projects, JPI Urban Europe funding agencies and other key players active in PED development.
