

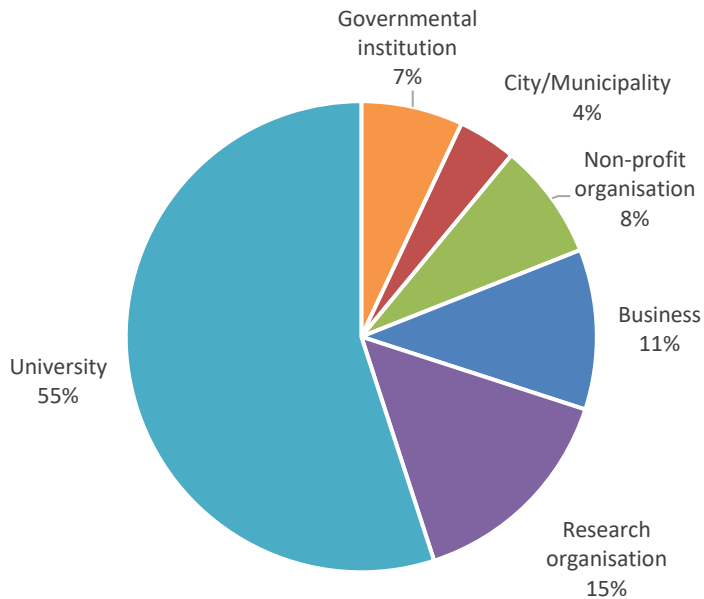

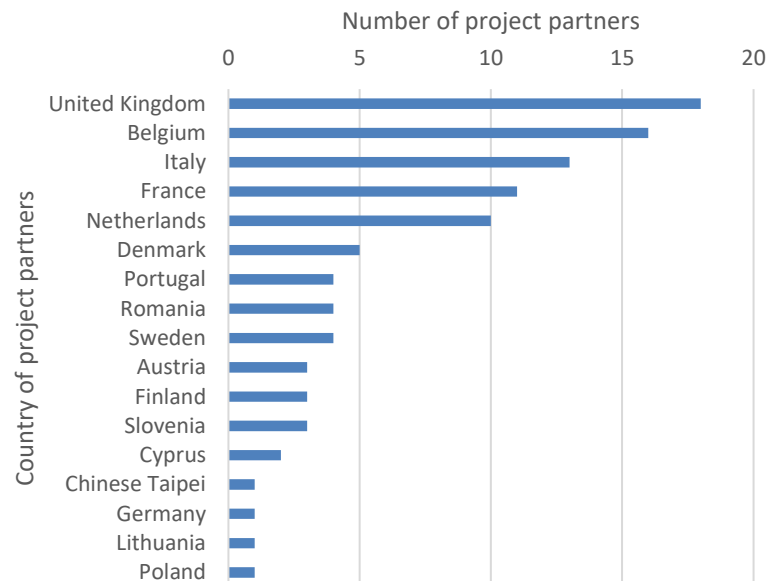


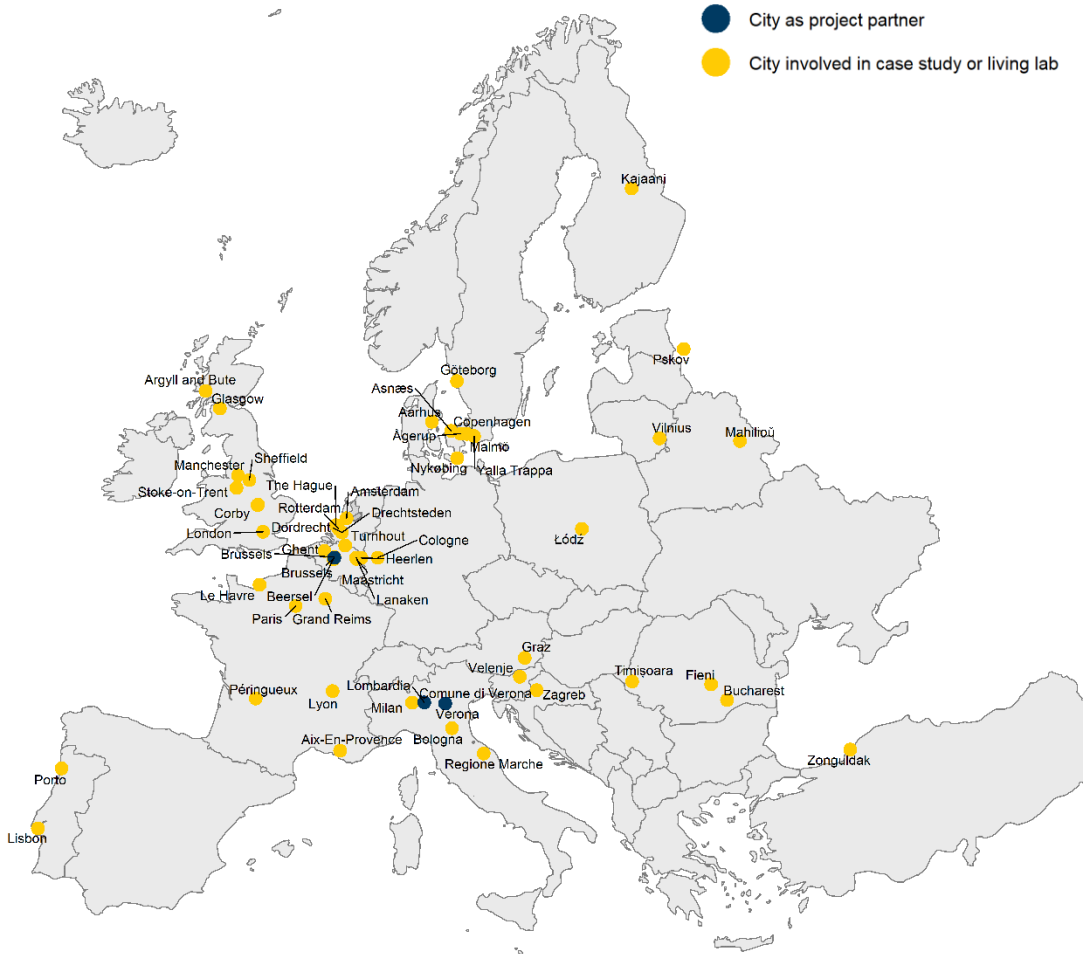

Largest number of involved city stakeholders

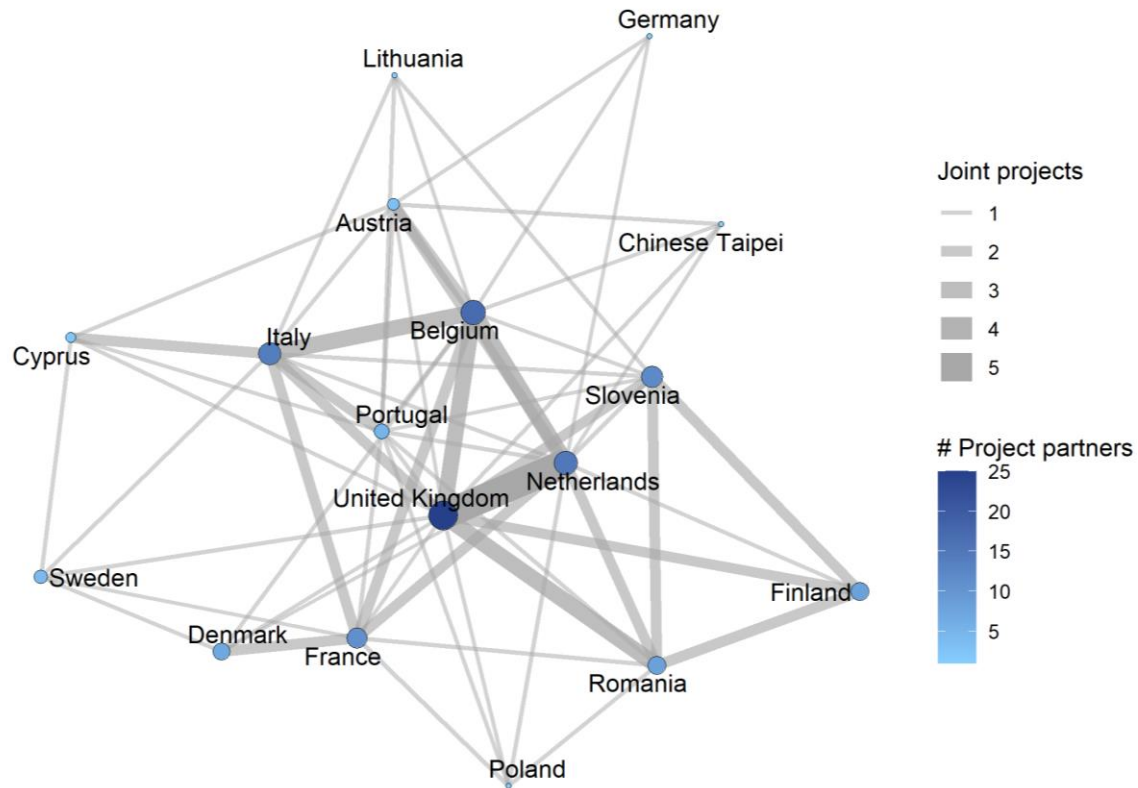
Broad geographical scope

Dense network among countries of project partners

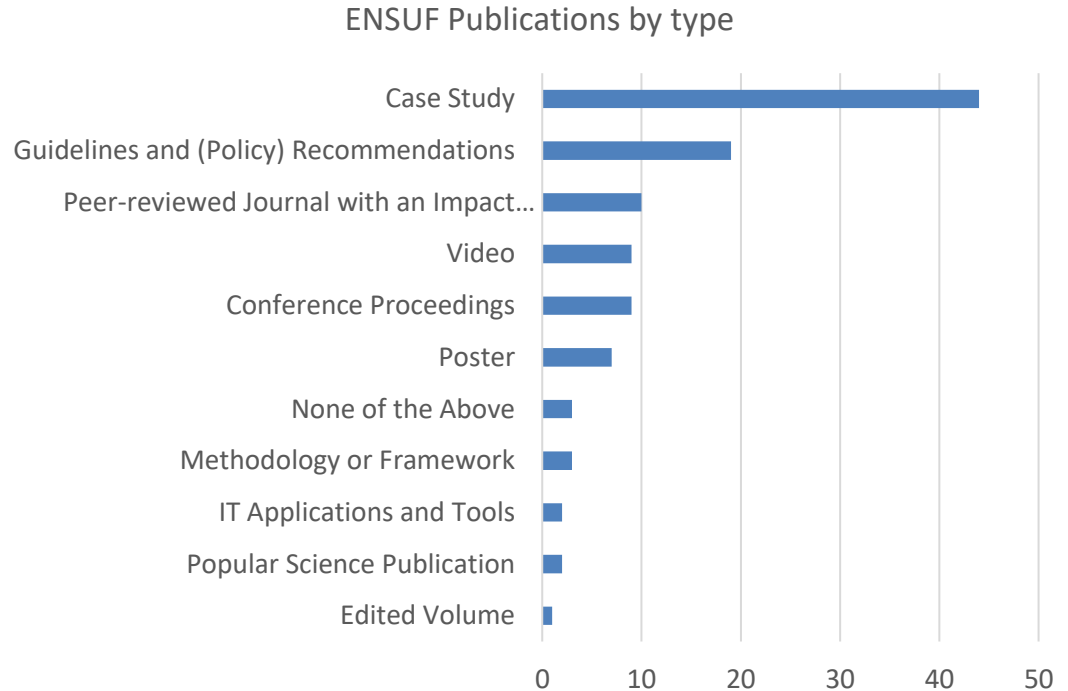
Hubs in Belgium, United Kingdom and Netherlands

Countries with fewer project partners also well connected



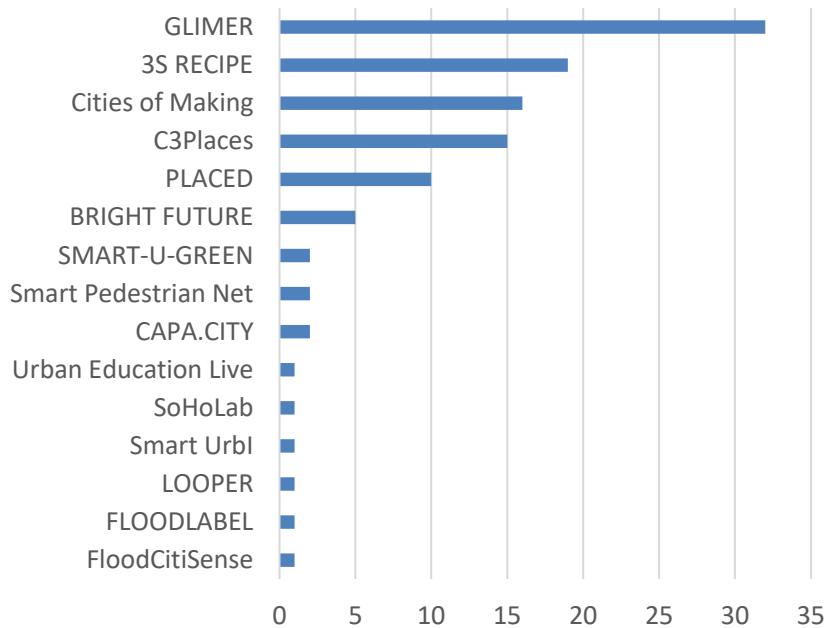
Project outputs and dissemination

- All project websites websites including 1250 pages

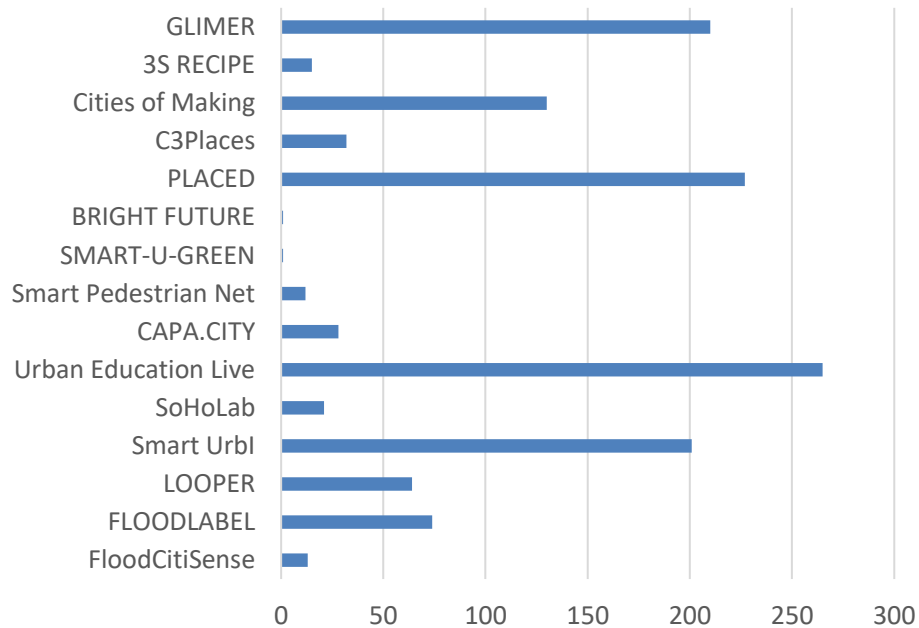


Outputs per project

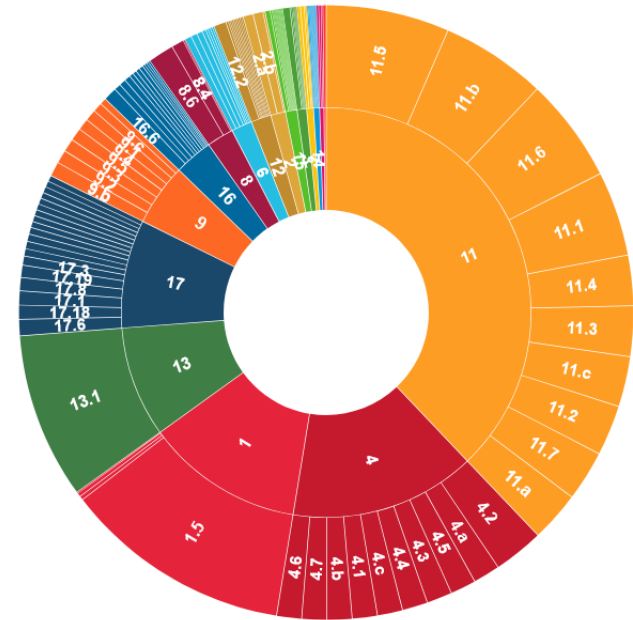
